


Under the leadership of Digidhan Coordinator Prof. Ramdas P. Bagawade , our college (6766) started Cashless campus movement.

As part of Maharashtra Digidhan Awareness Program, we PES's College of Engineering, Phaltan (DTE Code:-6766) has made available the facility of cashless transactions in our campus. College store accepts the payment by using BHIM App. College transfers Provident Fund and Professional Tax of all faculties by internet banking only. College pays electricity bill and mobile bill always with online banking. Also all other payments whose cost more than Rs. 500 are done with only Cheque mode.



In college currently all 60 faculties are making use of BHIM App for transaction purpose. Also 440 students of our college are using BHIM App.





College had also organized training program about cashless payment methods on  $6^{\rm th}$  January 2017. During this training program Mr. Vasudev Tamhanakar, Phaltan Branch Manager

Axis Bank, given details regarding different government initiated payment options for cashless transaction such as

- 1. Cheque
- 2. Demand Draft,
- 3. Online Transfer- NEFT or RTGS,
- 4. Credit Card or Debit Card
- 5. E-Wallets
- 6. Mobile Wallets
- 7. UPI Apps (**BHIM App**, SBI Pay, ICICI Pocket, Axis Pay UPI App, Union Bank UPI App, PNB UPI, PhonePe, TranZapp)
- 8. Gift Card
- 9. Aadhaar Enabled Payment System
- 10. Unstructured Supplementary Service Data

220 students of Computer, Civil, E & TC and Mechanical Department were Present for the workshop.



After this workshop Computer department students did campaigning in nearby villages to peculate the learnt cashless payment modes on 27<sup>th</sup> January 2017 as an ISR activity.
