7	Historic Place: Aundh Museum (Shri Bhavani Museum) Located about an hour away, it houses 500+ exquisite miniature paintings, Western artworks, and famous sculptures like Henry Moore's Mother and Child.	
8	Dhumalwadi Water fall: Locally known as <i>Navkund</i> , the site features nine consecutive small and medium waterfalls, offering a magical, near-heavenly ambiance filled with fluttering butterflies and lush surroundings.
