





3. Financial Schemes and Support:

Also he covered various financial schemes and support mechanisms available for entrepreneurs.

- Government grants and subsidies for startups.
- Venture capital and angel investors.
- Crowd funding and peer-to-peer lending.
- Banking and financial institution support.




Photo: Mr. Shaikh sir explaining Entrepreneurial Roadmap

4. Business Planning:

Effective business planning was emphasized as a critical step in securing financing. Entrepreneurs were advised to create comprehensive business plans that include:

- Clear business objectives and strategies.
- Financial projections and budgeting.
- Risk assessment and mitigation strategies.

5. Legal and Regulatory Aspects:

Entrepreneurs were reminded of the importance of understanding legal and regulatory requirements. Compliance with laws and regulations ensures the sustainability of a business.

Financial Schemes by Government:

1. Startup India:

The Startup India initiative was launched by the Indian government to promote entrepreneurship and innovation. It offers several benefits, including:

- Simplified compliance and self-certification.
- Tax benefits for startups.
- Access to a network of incubators and accelerators.
- Funding support through various government schemes and funds.

2. MUDRA (Micro-Units Development and Refinance Agency) Loan Scheme:

MUDRA offers loans to micro and small enterprises, including startups, at different stages of development. These loans are categorized into three segments - Shishu (up to ₹50,000), Kishor (from ₹50,000 to ₹5 lakhs), and Tarun (from ₹5 lakhs to ₹10 lakhs).

3. Stand-Up India:

This scheme is aimed at promoting entrepreneurship among Women and Scheduled Caste (SC) and Scheduled Tribe (ST) communities. It provides loans for setting up green field enterprises in manufacturing, services, or the trading sector.

4. National Credit Guarantee Trustee Company (NCGTC) Scheme:

NCGTC offers credit guarantees for loans provided to startups and small businesses. This scheme aims to reduce the risk for banks and other financial institutions, making it easier for startups to access loans.

5. Pradhan Mantri Mudra Yojana (PMMY):

PMMY is designed to provide financial support to micro-enterprises and startups in India. It offers loans up to ₹10 lakh to non-corporate, non-farm small/micro enterprises.

6. Credit Linked Capital Subsidy Scheme for Technology Up gradation (CLCSS):

This scheme is intended for technology up gradation in small-scale industries, including startups. It offers a subsidy for eligible businesses to upgrade their technology and machinery.

7. Export Promotion Capital Goods (EPCG) Scheme:

This scheme helps startups and other businesses to import capital goods for the production of export items. It offers duty benefits to reduce the cost of importing machinery and equipment.






