The Graduate Aptitude Test in Engineering (GATE) is a nationwide examination conducted and administered by the GATE Committee, comprising faculty members from IISc Bengaluru and the seven IITs. The exam is organized across eight zones in India on behalf of the National Coordinating Board, Department of Education, Ministry of Human Resource Development. GATE scores and ranks are widely used for admission to postgraduate programmes such as ME, M.Tech, MS, and Direct Ph.D. in premier institutions including IITs and IISc, as well as other institutes supported by MHRD. In addition, several Public Sector Undertakings (PSUs) utilize GATE scores for the recruitment of candidates to key technical positions offering attractive salary packages. GATE is recognized as a benchmark examination for entry into postgraduate education and for accessing rewarding career opportunities in PSUs, research organizations, and reputed academic institutions. Some institutions in India also grant admission to postgraduate programmes based solely on GATE performance.

The GATE examination holds significant importance due to the following factors:

1. It provides opportunities for admission into M.Tech programmes, which in turn enables students to participate in campus placements in leading national and international public and private sector organizations.
2. Several reputed Public Sector Undertakings (PSUs) and research organizations recruit candidates based on their GATE scores, including IOCL, NTPC, BHEL, PGCIL, BARC and other Navratna and Maharatna companies.
3. GATE qualification is also considered for Junior and Senior Research Fellowship positions in premier institutions and organizations such as ISRO, DRDO, BARC, CSIR, and IITs.
4. It serves as an eligibility criterion for Scientist 'C' grade posts in selected scientific and research bodies.

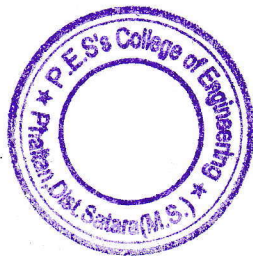
