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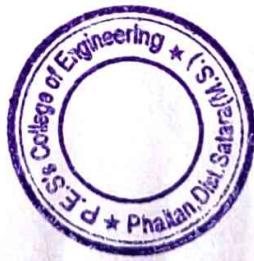
INTERNSHIP POLICY

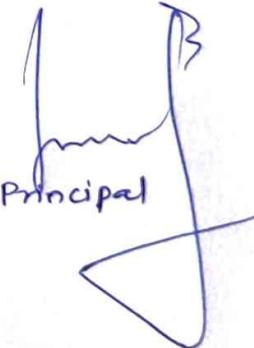
IMPLEMENTATION OF MANDATORY INTERNSHIP POLICY FOR STUDENTS

1. As per AICTE and DBATU norms, it is mandatory for every student enrolled in B.Tech program to complete the prescribed internships during their 4 years of Engineering, failing which a student may not be eligible to receive the degree certificate even after completion of necessary course credits. 2. Internships are educational and career development opportunities, providing practical experience in a field or discipline.
3. The main aim of the Internship is enhancement of the employability skills of the students passing out from Technical Institutions.
4. The curriculum includes mandatory internships at different stages, including a six-month full-time internship in the final semester (Semester VIII) as per DBATU NEP-compliant guidelines.
5. Students must complete minimum 4 weeks internship as follows:
 - o After 1st year (evaluated in 2nd year Semester III)
 - o After 2nd year (evaluated in 3rd year Semester V)
 - o After 3rd year (evaluated in Semester VII)
 - o Six months full-time in Semester VIII (BTMI801 - Internship/Project in industry)

INTERNSHIP POLICY:

1. The students are instructed and encouraged from time to time to apply for various internships of their choice. Students may also undertake certified trainings suggested by the department.
2. Students identify and secure internship opportunities independently during semester breaks or as per schedule.
3. Students undergo Industrial Training/Internship at the concerned Industry/Organization.
4. The student on successful completion of Internship needs to obtain the Certificate from the Industry/Organization.
5. Students submit the Internship Certificate along with a report to the concerned department.
6. For evaluation:
 - o Lower year internships (100 marks): Report + Internship Certificate + PPT Presentation
 - o Semester VIII Internship (BTMI801, 100 marks, 8 credits): As per DBATU guidelines (Continuous Assessment 60 marks + End Semester Exam 40 marks; may include NPTEL/university exam if applicable)
7. The concerned department maintains the records of all internships.
8. Training & Placement Cell supports students by providing guidance and suggestions for internship opportunities. Departmental Internship Coordinators and Faculty Mentors monitor progress and evaluation.
