

1. Introduction

The SC/ST Cell of PES's College of Engineering, Phaltan continuously works to support and guide SC/ST students in availing government financial assistance. As part of this initiative, a guidance session was conducted to help students understand the procedure and importance of using the "Redeem Button" during scholarship and freeship application processing on the Maharashtra Government scholarship portal.

2. Objective of the Session

- To explain the purpose and functionality of the **Redeem Button** on the MahaDBT portal.
 - To ensure students can successfully complete the final step of their scholarship/freeship claim.
 - To reduce errors and delays caused due to misunderstanding regarding the redeem process.
 - To help students receive scholarship and freeship benefits on time.

4. Key Points Discussed

- Logging into the **MahaDBT Portal**
- Locating application status after submission



- Identifying when the **Redeem Button** becomes active
- Step-by-step demonstration of how to click **Redeem**
- Required bank details and verification before redeeming
- Common errors and how to avoid them
- Document checking before final submission
- Importance of redeeming scholarship on time for fund release

5. Outcome of the Program

- Students gained clarity regarding the use of the redeem button.
 - Many students initiated and completed the redeem process during the session.
 - Reduction in pending applications due to incorrect procedure.
 - Students expressed positive feedback and requested more technical support sessions.

- Travel concessions for exam/interview purposes (as per government norms)

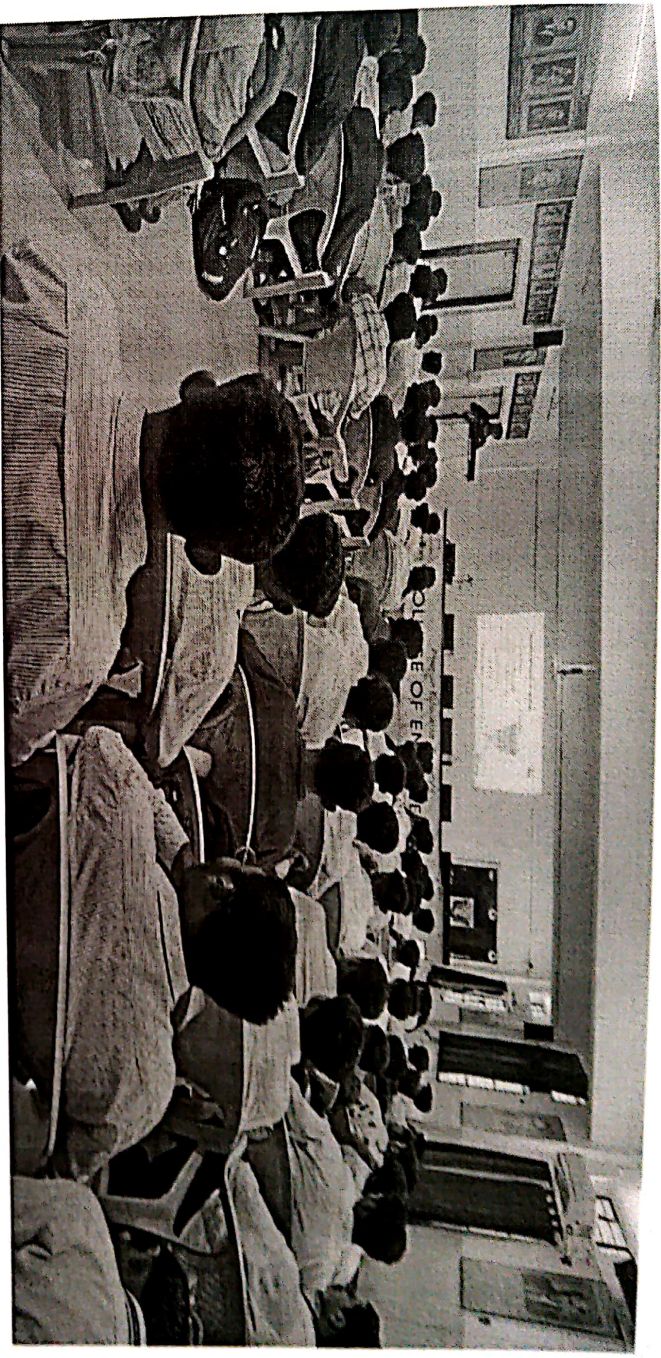
4. Guidance Given
